Update on Frank Navarro from Ben Strasser

(For you newer members, Frank was a long time member before moving and former Board member and Treasurer - J.S.)

Based on a post-operative analysis, things aren't going well. Surgeons, who said they would get it all, found that they were wrong. Now they want to do both radiation and chemo. So far MJ tells me that Frank doesn't want any part of it. He's very weak, actually even unable to sit up or get up from a chair and walk on his own. Due to the nerves being removed, his left hear and ear canal, plus he's unable to smile, has a drooping eyelid on the right eye, is physically unable to smile, and they say he still has the cancer that they were to have removed. So when they now talk about chemo and radiation his response so far has been, No. In his interest his Washington care givers are trying to contact his

son in Texas to see if he can come up and change Frank's mind - or at least give the go-ahead for the work doctors feel should be done. The doctors say (as they did before his 8+ hour operation) that the cancer will go into his jaw and will be very, very painful and he'll lose control of his jaw. But those are the exact same words they used before Frank allowed them to cut him, up so he wonders why bother? So, we'll see what happens.

At present he's in a recovery facility for 30 days primarily because the hospital dismissed him too early, (which seems to be the style these days because when they dismiss a patient sooner than has normally been done, the hospital gets a bonus from the Obamacare) then? And to make things more complicated for his caregivers up there (Ann's daughter Judy and her husband Scott), Frank's lady-friend and wonderful lady Ann is believed to be experiencing some sort of mental problems.

Kurt and I were going to go up for a brief visit, but while we had planned to do that early next week, what with the present state of "goings on" we'll have to wait a bit to see what his caregivers say about that. Obviously, if Frank wasn't conscious or experiencing some treatment we wouldn't be able to see him so we'll need to coordinate our visit with them.
