Greetings to all,

As of the September Meeting the membership is at 82.

Not much going on at the field the last month, the number of Members showing up still has been low. Membership turnout at the meetings has also been low.

FLOAT FLY UPDATE: The second Float Fly was on Saturday October 27, 2018. The turnout was good with about the same number of registered flyers. Lots of flying for those that turned out. Thanks to Bob Awtry, Bill Ardizzone, Jack Alloway, and Lee Buchoh for all their work with this event. I don't know how the Club can keep doing these events as this is too much for four of five members to do.

Remember that starting in membership year 2019, the Canyon Crosswinds annual dues will be \$250 per year for all Memberships except Junior Membership.

Junior Membership will be \$80 per year.

New Membership will be \$250 and there will be no Runway Fee.

The membership renewal period is open now and the renewal period closes March 1, 2019.

Have you been watching the local newspaper on new housing tracks in the valley? Seems that the county planning commission has approved two new developments in the field area, one is on Ridge Route Road north of the existing tracks and the other is in Tapia Canyon. The Ridge

Route Rd. development is scheduled to have 750 homes and Tapia Canyon is scheduled for 450 homes. Tapia Canyon is located between the Jail and Charlie Canyon. We will have to wait and see how fast these projects happen and what it means for the Club.

A couple of weeks ago the Club got a call from the Lake Office requesting keys to the old bathroom building. I had some keys made up and went to meet with Chris at the Lake. It seems that the park has come into some money that must be spent on refurbishment of park restrooms. New roofs, fixtures, lights, water supplies.

Stage one is new metal roofs on all the buildings and other repairs to come later. Chris said that this money will cover replacing the pumps and piping to the field so that water will be available. He also said part of the project is to repair/replace the irrigation system at the field. I asked him if the park had other plans for our site and he said no that they were happy with us. However I believe that if they complete all these repairs we will be looking at a lease increase to our site.

FIELD SAFETY ITEM: When flying to the west (lake) side of the field, watch out when heading to the south. We have had planes flying over the area where the heli members stand when flying. We don't need to fly over their heads so please stay out of that area. Also watch out for fingers and props. Thanks you.

FUEL UPDATE: As of this writing we have 2 gallons on hand. The Club is working on ordering some more. Smith Brothers does us a favor by selling it to the club for cost. So remember them when buying your rc supplies. See a club officer to purchase your fuel. The price is still \$20 a gallon.

The Board welcomes your ideals to make the club a better place for all members. We also welcome your criticism as long as it's constructive criticism. Remember your Board does the job for free and if you are unhappy with the Board or their actions then feel free to step up and run of office.

We are entering our Holiday Meeting Schedule. For November and December the meetings will take place on the **THIRD** Wednesday of the month to keep us away from the holidays. In January 2019 we will resume meeting on the Forth Wednesdays of the month.

The next regular Board-General Meeting will be at Mimi's Café, 24201 W Magic Mountain Parkway on **Wednesday November 14, 2018** at 7:00 PM. Come join us for dinner or a piece of pie, cake, or muffin and visiting. We meet at 6:00 P.M. for dinner. All members and guest are invited.
