Greetings to all,

As of the September Meeting the membership was at 98. That left 2 memberships open until we hit our 100-member cap.

**MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL.** With Membership renewals getting here, I'll give you another reminder about 2020 Membership dues. The dues for 2020 are again \$250 for open membership and \$80.00 for Junior Membership. Your dues may be paid anytime from **NOW** until **JANUARY 31, 2020**. After January 31, 2020 refer to the previous paragraph. If you are ready to renew print out a club application and change the year to 2020 fill it out and sent it in with your check. Keep in mind the cutoff date so if there is a waiting list you don't get left out.

For a long time, the club has given a grace period of one month with a \$10.00 late fee on renewals. This **HAS** been changed with the new cap. Starting in 2020 if a member's dues and not received by January 31, 2020 and there is a waiting list then the first person on the list will be invited to join the club. falls in line with our Club Constitution.
