We aren't the only field to close in the area, I heard that Victorville, Prado, and Apollo (The Basin) have closed as I'm sure most of the other fields in the area have closed.

As of the February 26, 2020 meeting the membership was at 85 members. With out having a March Meeting I don't have a up to date count but I think it may have increased one of two members.
