Greetings to all returning and new members!

ACTIVITIES AT THE FIELD:

The Park contractor is still working on the rehab of the brick building. We are still waiting for them to finish their electrical work inside the room so we can return our camera to service. They did finish with the roof replacement finally.

The 40-foot cargo container has been loaded with our field maintenance equipment and the

20-foot container has our picnic equipment in it. We did finish up with the clean out of the small container and building and had ALL the trash and junk taken away. Thanks to Bill Ardizzone, Jim Lansen, and Glenn Yamada for helping out on this task. We just have some old paint to get rid of at the next hazardous waste roundup in April. The new John Deere mower was delivered to the field on February 18, 2020.

CLUB OFFICER ELECTIONS

The elections take place at the June Meeting for Club Officers. Nominations normally open in April and close at the May meeting. The only requirement is being a CCW member for three years. So, if you are interested in running for any office just throw your name in and see what happens.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

The membership cap has not been reached at this time so membership is still open to all who wish to join.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

At the January meeting we talked about Junior Members and if they should count towards the membership cap. After discussion a motion was made to amend the Club Constitution Article V, Section 2. The motion states: **Section 2a. Junior Members Shall not be counted in the Club Membership cap.**

At the February Meeting we voted on this amendment and the amendment passed. So, a Junior Member **WILL NOT** count towards the membership cap of 100.

Also, the question was asked about the age limit for a Junior Member. A Junior Membership is for a member under the age of 18. If the Junior Member turns 18 during the membership year then the next membership year they must join as an

open member provided the Club has not reached its membership cap. If the club is at the cap then the Junior Member goes on the waiting list.
